Of course there are rules! After all the Orwigsburg town cops have to keep peace between all you high spirited chili cookers and keep our tasters safe. And no bribin' the judges! So, if you're hankerin' to prove you make the "chilliest chili" in town, head on over to the rules listed below.

Once you read the rules and figure you can still load your pot with the winning entry in spite of those dang regulations, complete the entry form, tell us all about yourself, and we'll give you a chance to concoct your heavenly (or not so heavenly) batch of homemade chili.

'Nuf said? See you there. Oh, by the way you'll have to bring your own already prepared and piping hot chili as well as a serving ladle. We will provide the chafing baskets, tables, tablecloths, tasting cups, bowls, spoons, and napkins.

Rules & Regulations for Chili Cookoff

1. Each applicant must complete an entry form and submit it no later than Wednesday, Oct. 4th.
2. A refundable entry fee of \$25.00 made payable to OBPA (to be refunded following participation) must be submitted with entry form.
3. Chefs may arrive as early as 4:30 PM to set up assigned serving area.
4. Chili must be prepared prior to event, brought piping hot and ready to serve in chafing dishes provided.
5. Each chef is required to bring **2 gallons** of chili for the event, unless notified otherwise.
6. Each chef must bring their own ladle to serve their chili.
7. All chili must be prepared and ready for tasting by 5:30 PM.
8. Any combination of meat can be used, but no garnishes.
9. Each attendee will receive a ballot to vote for People's Choice in both Professional & Amateur categories.
10. Chefs are encouraged to promote event and invite family, friends, and co-workers.
11. Judges' total scores for **Amateur** cooks will be of **best taste, best color, best aroma, best consistency, and best meat texture** determines final **1st, 2nd, and 3rd** place winners.
12. Judges' total scores for **Professional** cooks will be of **best taste, best color, best aroma, best consistency, and best meat texture** determines the **1st** place winner.
13. Chefs are asked not to clean/dismantle their area until after 8:30 PM
